Part of the experience at Hollis Crossings is to do COOP games. These non-competitive games teach team-work, leadership and listening skills; and it is a great way to emphasize a point.

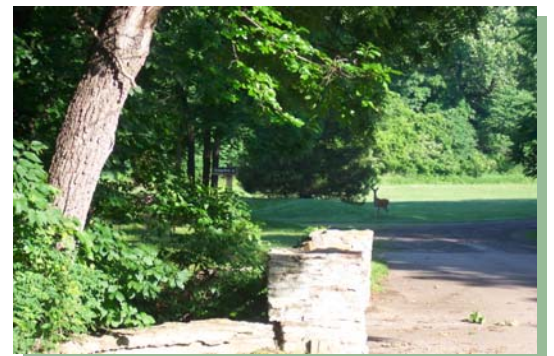
